## 05 CROWLEY HIGH

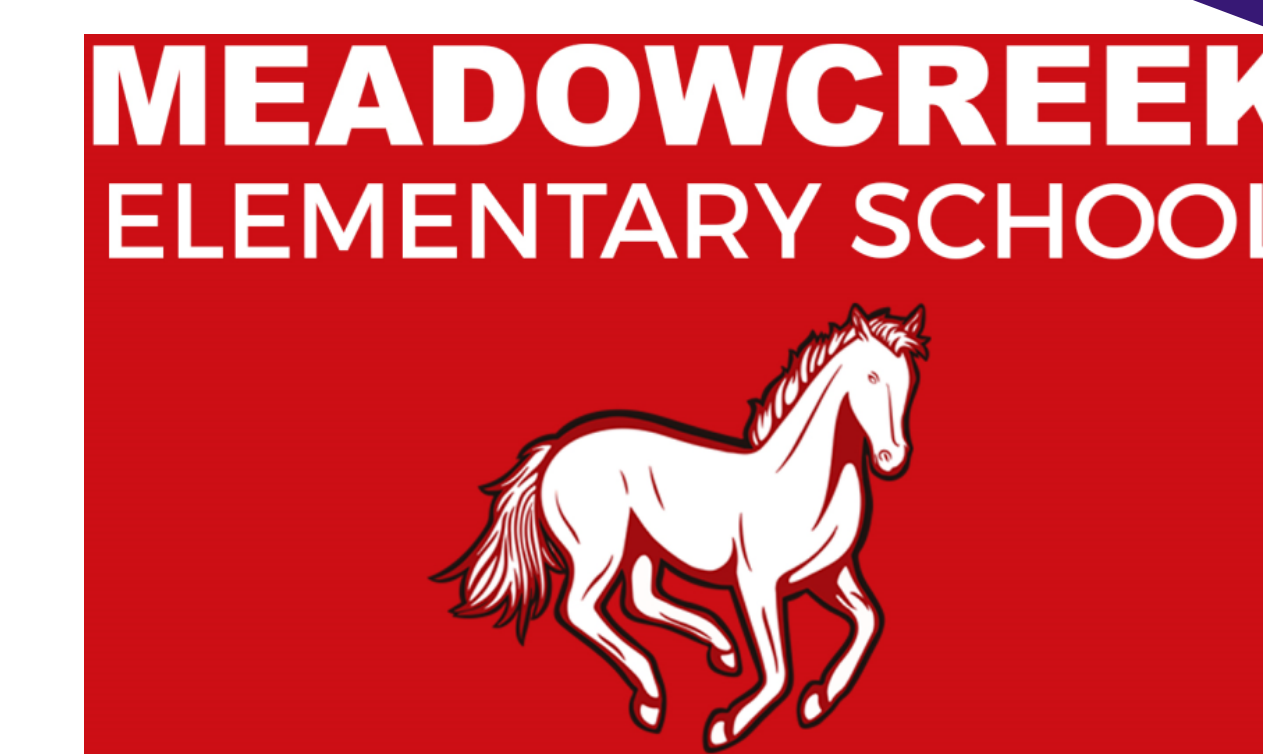
